RESPECT FOR NATURE

Since 1986, the Haut-Jura area has been protected by the Environmental Charter of the Haut-Jura Regional Nature Park. This includes peatland, dry grasslands, lakes, forests, rocky areas and more. The preserved wilderness of the Haut-Jura mountains is home to a wide range of animal and plant species, some of which are rare and protected. The region also pays particular attention to preserving biodiversity and developing local resources. Environmentally-friendly practices are at the heart of everyday choices.

A VIBRANT & GOURMET REGION

Thriving craftsmanship, inventive industry, sustainable tourism and active agriculture: these are the mainstays of the Haut-Jura's local economy.

Comté, Morbier, Bleu de Gex, Jura wines... these exceptional products embody living know-how, a source of identity and sharing.




OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES IN ALL SEASONS


SPRING IN THE HAUT-JURA

A FONDUE TO SAVOUR FROM THE HEIGHTS






ARCHAEOLOGICAL IMMERSION

In the heart of Saint-Claude, the basement of the Abbey Museum houses a major archaeological site in the restored former abbot's residence (15th-18th centuries). These are the largest and only known remains of Saint-Claude Abbey, founded in the 5th century and one of the oldest abbeys in France.

On the upper floors of the museum, you can also discover a magnificent fine arts collection based on donations from Guy Bardonne and René Genis, as well as one or two temporary exhibitions each year. In 2025, the museum will host Laurent Proux's exhibition, "L'Arbre et la Machine". Comprising some forty works, the exhibition explores the relationship between the body and the industrial world, blending naturalism and the imaginary. Through original works inspired by the industrial lands of the Haut-Jura, Laurent Proux confronts the rigour of workers' techniques with an idealised nature.


SUMMER IN THE HAUT-JURA

Then there are the hikes, walks near waterfalls, walks with animals, or sporting escapades at an altitude for a half-day to several days. Two emblematic routes await you: the Grande Traversée du Jura, through ridges, forests and wild valleys, and the Échappée Jurassienne, a 350km route between mountains and vineyards.


WINTER IN THE HAUT-JURA



SPOTLIGHT ON SAINT-CLAUDE

Situated in the hollow of a valley, crossed by the Bienne and the Tacon rivers, Saint-Claude forged its strong identity from its steep terrain. A city where culture, nature and history go hand in hand. It's a great place to explore on foot, with its frescoes, bridges, quaint alleyways, workshops and shops.

Saint-Claude traces its origins back to the Middle Ages, when the monks Romain and Lupicin settled here. Their monastery became a powerful abbey and a major pilgrimage site until the 18th century. Louis XI himself came to visit the relics of Saint Claude. A specific craft industry developed around these religious roots: wood-turning, rosaries, pipes and snuffboxes.

The town became the capital of pipemaking and also gained renown for its diamond-cutting. Saint-Claude has been awarded the Ville et Métiers d'Art label.



A monument to history!

AN ARCHITECTURAL GEM

The cathedral of Saint-Pierre, Saint-Paul and Saint-André, a listed historic monument, boasts a number of masterpieces, including sculpted choir stalls, an Italian Renaissance altarpiece, a Romanesque organ, original stained glass windows and a chapel dedicated to Saint Claude. The Tourist Office offers guided tours all year round to discover its many secrets, from its foundation in 430 to the present day. To extend the experience and understand the unique history of Saint-Claude, follow a guide through the town and explore its landmarks, from historic buildings to quaint alleyways, must-see squares and lots more.

VISIT A PIPE-MAKING WORKSHOP

The Genod Viou workshop in Saint-Claude has been making briar pipes since 1865. Sébastien selects quality briar, hand-crafts the chamber and fits an ebonite or zebu-horn shank. Visits to the workshop are organised throughout the year, allowing visitors to discover the different stages of production, from roughing to polishing, and to admire an exhibition of antique and sculpted pipes.


DISCOVER DUAL EXPERTISE

Just a stone's throw from Saint-Claude cathedral, the Pipe and Diamond Museum showcases two emblematic skills that have forged the town's identity: pipe-making and diamond-cutting. A truly unique exhibition, the first part of the museum reveals the world of the master pipe-makers through tools, historical machines and an impressive collection of local and international pipes. The tour continues with a lapidary workshop animated by automata, a selection of gem stones, replicas of famous diamonds and exceptional jewels. A film recounting the history and techniques of gem-cutting completes the experience. The chapter house, the ceremonial venue of the brotherhood, is also open to the public.


